


## An Owl Mask





Owl Mask Level: Easy Duration: 1 hour

## **KEY**






Mountain fold

Valley fold



## You will need:

Heavy white paper (around 150gsm). Craft knife, cutting mat, scissors, ruler, glue, bone folder (or ballpoint pen without the ink), hole puncher, tape, elastic & coloured pens (optional).



1. Choose a template to work from. Design and colour your own mask on the blank template or use the one I have already illustrated. Print onto heavy white paper.



2. Cut out all the parts. Use a scalpel to cut out the eye holes and a hole puncher to cut the two small holes for the elastic.



3. Score and fold all the dashed and dotted lines (dashed line = mountain fold, dotted line = valley fold). If you don't have a bone folder for scoring, you can use a ballpoint pen without the ink.




4. Glue Tabs A,B and C to their respective parts, making the shape more 3-dimensional. For extra strength, tape together the underside.





5. Apply glue to the tabs on the beak and stick onto the mask at points D and E. Hold in place until dry.




6. Tie (or staple) ends of elastic through the small holes. The length of the elastic should fit around your head.
